

Isabel Scionti Piano Performance Scholarship

This scholarship is named in honor of Isabel Scionti, a generous benefactor of DMTA with a long and distinguished career as a performer and a teacher.

Please read carefully the following information.

All applicants must be high school seniors who are students of a DMTA teacher. Applicants must play two memorized, contrasting pieces from different periods of music for a judge on the competition date. Students must bring the original publisher copy of the music for the use of the judge. Students with photocopies will not be allowed to play. The judge will select a winner (or winners, at the discretion of the judge) for the scholarship. All participants will receive a critique sheet. The judge and the committee reserve the right not to name a winner.

Names of participating students must be given to the chairman by the deadline (consult Yearbook or Calendar).

The winner (or winners) must perform at the DMTA Senior Scholarship Recital. A cash award will be given at that recital.
