Saturday recitals are tentatively scheduled for 10am, 1:30pm, and 3pm, and Sunday recitals are tentatively 2pm and 3pm. Recital times may be combined at the discretion of the chairperson. Please indicate at least first and second choices for recital times. Choice of times can be indicated as mid-morning, late morning, early afternoon, and late afternoon.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Students in grades 0-12.

**ENTRY FEE:** \$10.00 per student

## **REQUIREMENTS:**

*Instrumental:* One movement of a sonata (no time limit) or multiple movements (5 minutes or less) or one or more movements of a sonatina (5 minutes or less).

**Vocal:** A song of serious artistic intent, that tells a story and/or expresses human emotions, as distinct from a folk song or pop music.

**Strings:** A classical piece from the baroque, classical, romantic, or modern periods that demonstrates the use of binary form, ternary form, rondo form or in distinctive sections. Recommended repertoire from the Suzuki method or solos for young violinists/violists are appropriate.

Participants must perform by memory in a series of recitals. Students will receive a certificate of participation and a ribbon. Those participating for 4, 8, or 12 years receive a trophy.

ENTRY INFO: Please fill out information on a 3 x 5 clean note card for each student. Remember to list student's grade, but not age. Please list the opus number if applicable with the tempo marking for the movement(s). Indicate trophy information with a red pen.

Include a copy of a master list with only students' names and requested first and second choices of recital day and times.
